**A. The one thing from today's summit that I will remember:**

NARCAN administration and app (25); stats; opioid use is a serious concern; Monte; the impact of opioid in the community and having people who lived the experience can be impactful; impacts with mental health; the truth about opioid use; PEER Specialist Panel and their stories (7)!; signs of an overdose; I have gained knowledge on substance abuse and how to help my peers; the stats for maternity and opioids; vey educational; the information that was shared; how deadly opioids are; how to help someone who has overdosed; everything was well; what Arkansas is doing to help with the opioid crisis; how to better serve our community and families; Arkansas is #2 in opioid prescriptions (3); everything was great; Narkansas.com; ARORP application process; I have personal hope for my family; application process is easy; the help that is out there for addiction; there is funding to help your community; Ashley County has a problem with opioid misuse; some facts I learned about behavior of child from maternal mental health; I will remember the great amount of support provided; never enable; more training for rural areas; people being there for others is what works; there are many resources for moms in Arkansas; recovery is possible; prevention; all the info on opioid and substance misuse.

**B. As a result of the information shared, one thing that I will do differently:**

Add Parent Education; More or better understanding of individuals who are going through substance abuse; be more understanding of how easy it is to become addicted; educate others on the opioid epidemic and how important preventions is; how to handle different situations; not to be so judgmental (2) ; NARCAN; be more mindful when dealing with drug/mental persons; look for and utilize PEER Specialists; never to be an enabler; not to judge others and to seek help; pay more attention to the needs of my teen; find ways to get; choose words differently when working with people struggling with substance abuse; be more aware of people who are suffering from substance abuse; naloxone training for staff in centers (2); get more information on substance abuse; how to handle someone who is still going through it; think of how opioids affect people; share knowledge with families; look into seeking more funding; look at signs of drugs in my families and community and refer them to PEER Support programs; lessen the stigma; share the opioid information; be more aware of mental health and it's effect on families; be more aware of resources; share the info I have learned with others; becoming more aware of the issues with opioids in my community; better able to identify opioid use; check on friends and families that are pregnant and let them know the resources that they have if they need it; my views about the stigma have changed-I was guilty of only seeing a junkie versus a person in distress; view those suffering through addiction differently and give grace; emotional state/being of addiction and the person-better understanding; reach out more; get Naloxone in more communities; advocate; the opioid crisis is very high; carry naloxone; help families and teachers on awareness; share this information; be more mindful of the problem; be more supportive of our struggling mothers; network more to provide families with the necessary support that's needed; be more aware; watch for new moms to be safe; give substance abusers there time and space; the way I look at drug addiction; be more aware of the addiction; try to find resources and help for families in these circumstances.

**C. One item/issue from today that I wish we could have spent more time on:**

Identifying addiction; more information about the misuse of opioids; effects of usage on children; opioid prevention; stress management; risks associated with opioid dependency; programs available; drug prevention and referral information; resources of recovery; grant; maternal mental health: impact on children and parenting with Dr. Jessica Coker (4); they were all good; mental health with children and families; understanding drug abuse; listening to Monte and his panel; effects of opioid abuse; how parental drug abuse affect children; more research on drug addiction; training trainers on how to be opioid prevention trainers through immersive opioid education and interaction; grants for programs; how to save a life with NARCAN; good overview; know what our families need; everything was great and knowledgeable; effects of drugs on early childhood education; awareness; how to apply for funding; testimonies; more ways that families can help people with addiction.
