

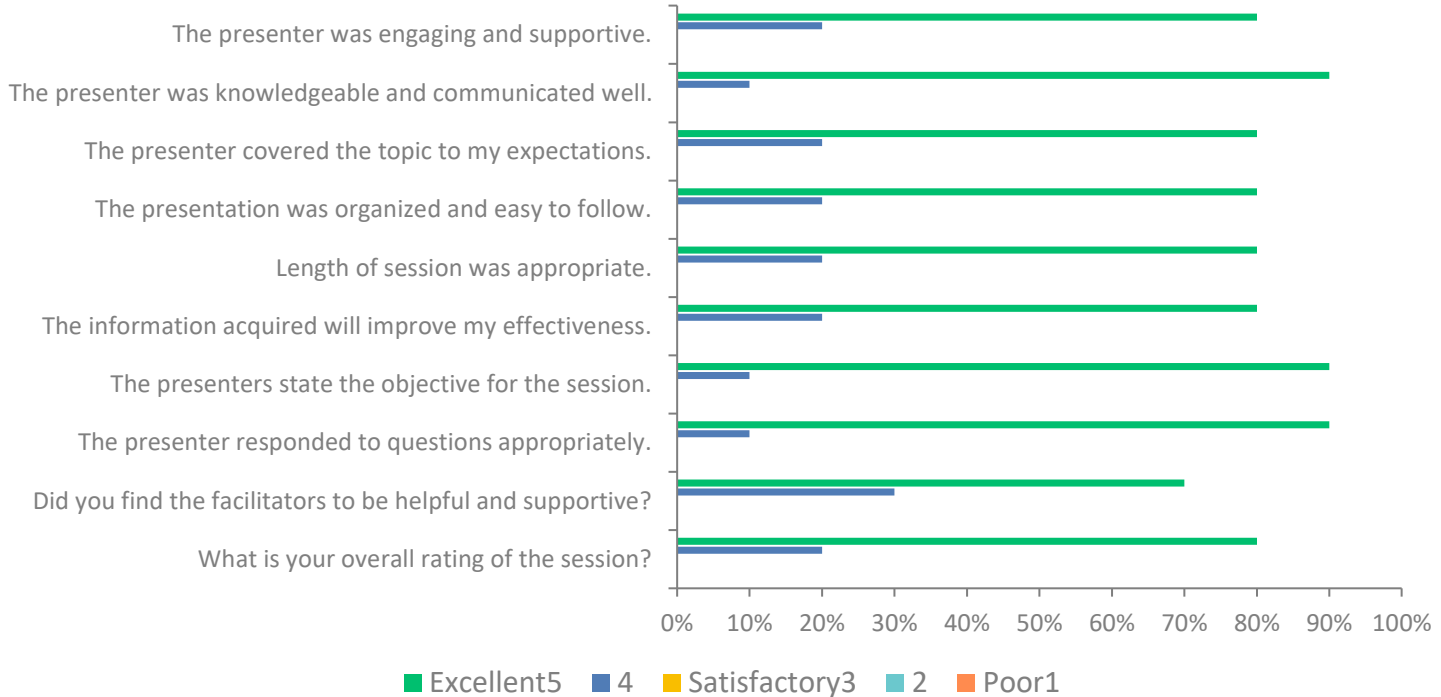

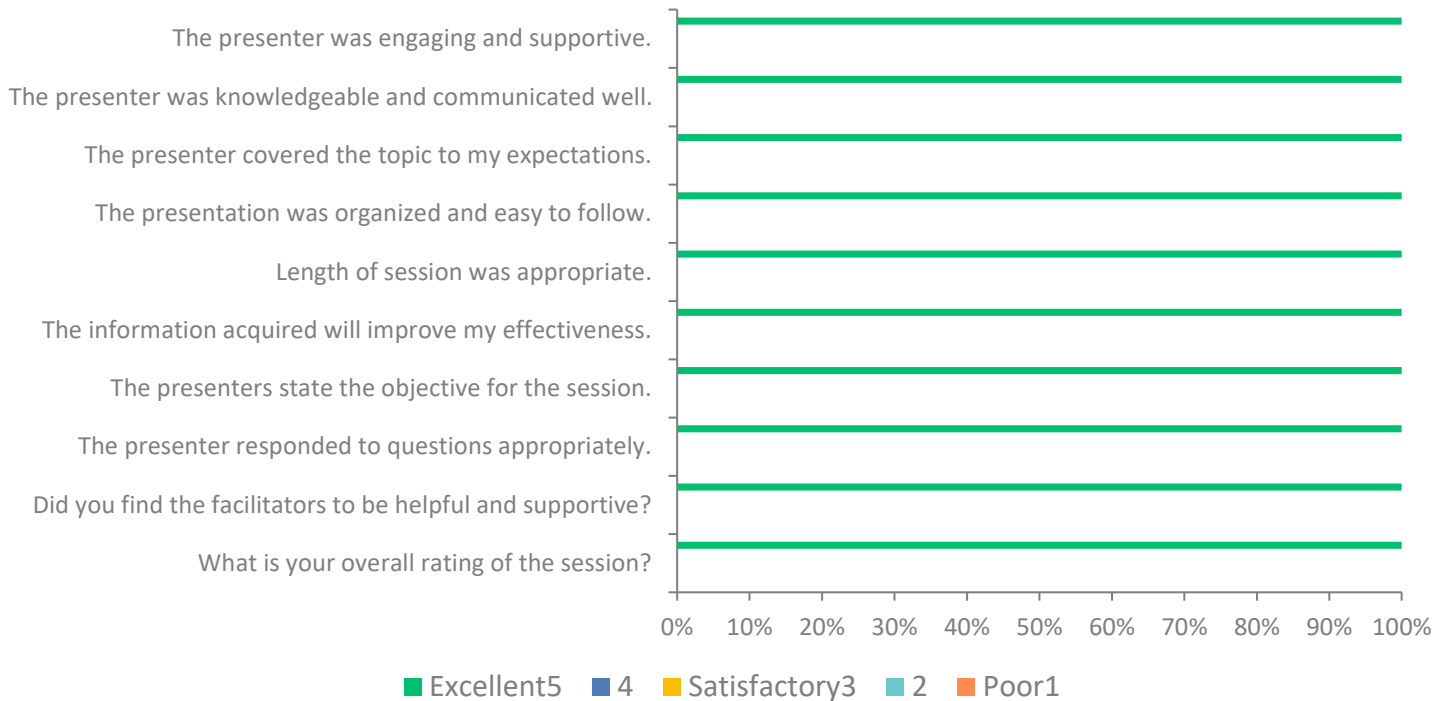
Very motivational

Great demonstration of accepting challenges and being resilient when the computer froze!

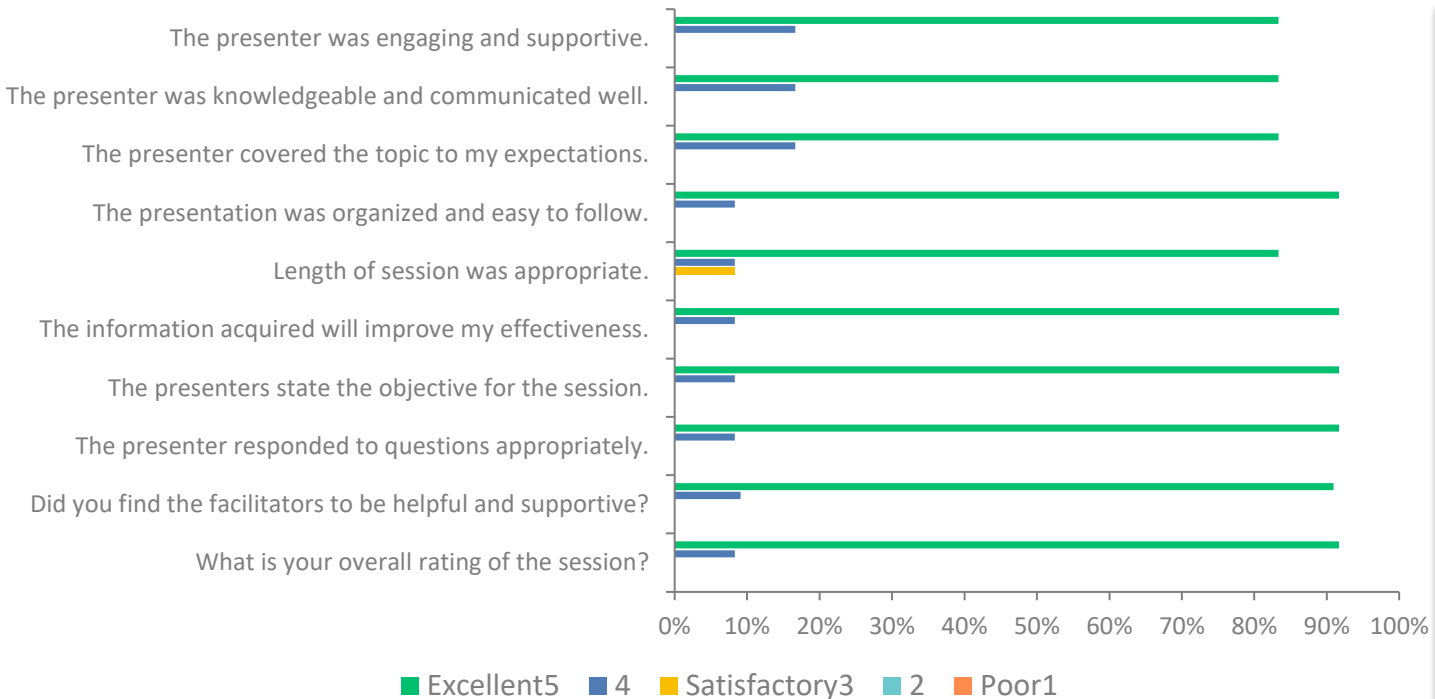
